RED RIBBON WEEK – October 24 – October 28

Our school Family Resource Center (FRC) staff will visit classrooms each day to tally number of students and classroom assigned staff participating for each day. There will be three spirit point races as follows: TK – 1st, 2nd – 3rd and Burkam's 1/2 split, 4th – 5th and Merchant's 3/4 split. The class from each of the three races (three total winning classes) with the highest spirit point count on Friday, October 28 will be presented a Red Ribbon Spirit Winner certificate for each student and the FRC will arrange with the teacher to honor an added recess play time to take place between October 31 and November 10. Spirit points are tallied by percentage of participation by students and staff assigned to the class. Here are some examples, a class with 24 students enrolled and 1 staff member who has 21 total participants on a given day earns 84% for that day. A class with 22 students assigned and 2 staff members who has 17 total participants on a given day earns 71%. If a student or staff member is absent on a given tally day, the total number is not changed, as it goes by total enrolled/assigned to the class. At the end of the week a class' five totals are tallied and divided by 500 (100% possible for each day). So, a class that has 80%, 69%, 99%, 75%, and 77%/500 would have a total spirit point score of 80% overall. In the event of a tie within a group race, the tiebreaker will be the class who had the highest % on any given day.

CARNIVAL - October 27, 2016 -- 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Presale tickets will be \$5.00 for 20 tickets to be redeemed at activity booths and food concessions. Presale ticket orders will be honored through 2:30 p.m. on Friday, October 21. Please turn in preorder ticket forms to our school office. After the 21st and at the door ticket price will be \$7.00 for 20 tickets. The activities and food concessions will be hosted by our school staff and volunteers. Children (at parent discretion) and adults are welcome to come to the carnival in costume, however, this is not required to enjoy and take part in the event. We will have the Shady Creek Sugar Shack silent dessert auction from 4:00-5:20 p.m. with winners announced at 5:30 p.m. Proceeds from Sugar Shack go towards 5th grade tuition to Shady Creek. For \$10.00 per 6" x 6" ceramic tile, your family may leave a piece of history at Team Lone Tree. We will have a booth to purchase and decorate the tiles for a mass collection for firing and mounting.
