Lone Tree School/Wheatland Charter Academy Registration begins for Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten Students for the 2017-2018 School Year with our Kindergarten Roundup

Team Lone Tree would like to welcome all of our incoming students and their parents. We will begin registration for Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten on March 1, 2017. In order to be eligible for Kindergarten, your child's fifth birthday must fall on or before September 1, 2017. Children whose fifth birthday falls between September 2 and December 2 are eligible for our Transitional Kindergarten program.

Please be sure your child is up to date on all immunizations. Your child may require a TB skin test, depending upon the outcome of your TB survey that is to be completed at registration, and per California Code 120325 all students must be immunized prior to school entry. See reverse side for immunization chart from California Department of Public Health.

All entering kindergartners must submit an oral health assessment (dental check-up) prior to May of 2018. To encourage taking care of this early, all students with forms complete and submitted to the school office by September 29, 2017, will be awarded a book with a student addressed note signed by the Principal on October 2, 2017. These forms are available in the school office to take to a licensed dentist or other registered dental health professional and may be completed now.

Proof of birth is required in the form of a birth certificate, baptismal certificate or other legal verification in order to register your child. In addition to proof of birth and Immunizations, we will need to have proof of residency if you are living within our district, but not on the Military Installation (example: water bill, PG&E, etc.). If you are currently residing outside of the Wheatland School District, you will need to obtain an Inter-District Agreement. If you live in the Placer or Western Placer School Districts, your Inter-District Agreement will need to be initiated at the district of your residence and can be requested now. Students residing in other districts may pick up a form in our office at the time of enrollment.

Checklist of what is required for classroom assignment:

- ◆ Birth certificate
- ◆ Verification of address with inter-district agreement for families living outside of the Wheatland Elementary School District boundaries.
- ◆ Immunization Records, including TB assessment and, if required, proof of test.
