We work on a positive reinforcement system and aim on ending every student's day on a positive stick color. Mrs. Garcia will call parents if the child's negative behavior is consistent and a concern and child and parent will fill out an Action Plan.

	<p><b><u>Green Day</u></b> = I'm having a good day!</p> <p>(All children start their day as green)</p>
	<p><b><u>Blue Day</u></b> = I'm having a great day!</p> <p>(I was caught making good choices)</p>
	<p><b><u>Yellow Day</u></b> = I'm having an excellent day!</p> <p>(I was caught making good choices again)</p>
	<p><b><u>Red Day</u></b> = I need a warning to stop behavior (When I am caught making good choices I go back to green and continue changing my stick up to yellow.)</p>
<p>clothes pin removed from chart</p>	<p>= I need a time out (When I gain control and make good choice, I go back to green and have the opportunity to go up to blue, removal of my clothes pins means I am not able to end on a yellow day.)</p>
