










As teachers we are often asked what parents can do at home to help their children advance academically. One of the best things you can do is read aloud to your child frequently.

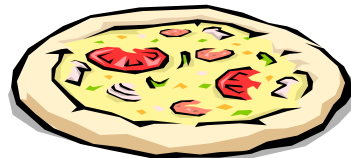
